

Job Opportunities – Alpine Rental Shop and Snow School Supervisor

Manning Park Resort located 45min East of Hope, BC. We are currently recruiting for a full time seasonal Rental Shop / Snow School Supervisor to join our team. This position works within our Snow School and is responsible for coordinating the scheduling of all our ski & snowboard instructors.

This is a full time seasonal position commencing in November and running until approximately April.

Summary of Responsibilities

Reporting to the Ski Hill Operations Manager, the Supervisor's primary task is managing the rental shop personal and instructors' schedules and ensuring appropriate and fair workloads are divided equally among the staff. The Supervisor must work closely with the Manager, Supervisor(s) and Coordinators to ensure that the on-hill product remains of the highest quality.

Responsibilities:

- To uphold Manning Park Resorts' mandate of "Super service with a smile".
- Compliance with all Manning Park Resorts' policies and procedures as set out in the Employee Handbook.
- The Supervisor is responsible for overseeing the day-to-day schedules for the rental shop and instructing staff.
- Assists with hiring and training instructors, and monitoring staffing levels.
- Scheduling hub for all private lessons.
- The Supervisor works with the other supervisors and coordinators to oversee delivery of lessons and rental gear. Liaise with Manager to resolve any critical customer complaints.
- Maintains a working staff list for the entire department.
- Various administrative duties, including: managing instructor uniforms, start-up and termination packages, managing booking files and calendars, ordering operating supplies.

Terms of Employment:

- Salaried Position Paid Bi-Weekly: 40 per week (overtime will be necessary at times).
- Seasonal November to April.
- Must be able to work weekends, holidays
- Salary based on experience and qualifications.

Qualifications:

- Ideally a certified instructor with either CSIA or CASI Level 1 or equivalent although would consider someone uncertified with good skiing or snowboarding skills who is highly organized.
- Excellent organizational skills.
- Strong Administration Skills.
- Cash handling / retail experience
- At least two (2) years Ski & Snowboard industry experience.
- Previous supervisory or management experience.
- Good knowledge of the winter recreation industry.
- Excellent communication and supervisory skills.
- Goal orientated with good time management abilities, Strong team leader, with the ability to keep instructors motivated and focused.
- Excellent guest service skills; previous customer service experience and asset.
- Proven experience with MS Office (particularly Word, Excel, and Outlook)
- Previous scheduling experience an asset.
